



## Former DC Department of General Services (DGS) Head Brian Hanlon Returns to Brailsford & Dunlavy

He led the consolidation of the agency, established its vision and mission, automated and streamlined the management of 27 million square feet of real estate, created the first preventative maintenance platform, led the City's first successful public-private partnership, and built several billion dollars in award winning new schools, parks, laboratories, and various municipal facilities. With six operating divisions, a staff of 700, and an annual budget of over \$1 billion, Mr. Hanlon modernized real estate development and operations for the District. He also revolutionized the City's energy procurement and management platform, spearheading the City's wind and solar energy deal and paving the way for hundreds of millions of dollars in savings.
